President

General

The President is both the business and social head of the Club and is responsible for the general well-being of the Club. His commitment therefore is directed towards the ongoing development of the Club within its rules, policy and philosophy. He should possess a sound background knowledge of the Club, its history and its constitution and have an awareness of its legal and social responsibilities.

Specific duties

- The President will be responsible for the conduct of general and committee meetings.
- To ensure meetings start on time.
- To have a prepared agenda circulated in advance of meeting so as committee members come prepared.
- To follow this agenda and have a good knowledge of the items contained in it.
- To conduct meetings in a manner that is unbiased but not passive and be able to lead and direct proper discussion without diversions.
- As an ex-officio member of all sub-committees the President should attend these meetings when necessary, but should not interfere with the running of these meetings.
- Maintain and control the clubhouse alarm, its keys and register of users.

Leadership role

- To ensure that decisions and policies of the committee are carried out correctly and promptly.
- To be firm but not dictatorial to ensure that difficult or controversial problems are discussed with fellow officers of the Club and are handled correctly.
- To always be encouraging to committee members and make them aware of the responsibility of their position in the Club.
- To take an active interest in members and the concerns that they may have.

Obligations

- To set the standard in dress and behaviour and lead by example.
- To host official visitors and visiting clubs.
- To support as many social occasions as possible.
- Be prepared to make formal and informal speeches at club events/occasions.
