January/February

- It is good to be back in operation again the club has had a reasonable trading month for December 2020 All fees have now been received. We have installed an EFTPOS machine attached to our Bendigo Bank Account to handle over the counter bar purchases. This was not the cheapest but, I believe, we are better dealing with one banking institution instead of multiple providers of banking services.
- The charges will be \$30 per month rental of the equipment and 1.2% for transactions. For the month of December, the Merchant Fee was \$2.66 and \$191.90 passed through the process.
- We will not be providing CASH OUT facilities as I do not believe we can expect our volunteers to handle this process. The bar has made a slight profit for the period.
- Our major expenses are yet to be paid for the year i.e., Affiliation Fees to VGL approx. \$24K, Insurance approx. \$5K and support for computer systems approx. \$5K.
