BBQ – Russell has been looking at various options. One option is to get one from Bar B Ques are Us on Maroondah Highway, Heatherdale/Mitcham. However, he has not found them very good to deal with and is still looking at other possible suppliers. He is hoping to get this sorted before the May meeting. He has enlisted the help of Stan Edwards generally but in particular when it comes to installation.

NBN/Telstra – Office phone now working. Refund of \$647.28 received from Telstra for unused phone last 12 months

Player unwell on course – protocols to be established and members to be supported when unwell

Membership numbers – 26 new members have joined since October 31, placing pressure on Monday and Wednesday blocks. After discussion it was decided to not accept any new members until after June 30, when it will be re-assessed.

Pennant information distribution – template to be set up by Captain to enable distribution to competing clubs next year.
