The weekly till ring-offs showed a gain for the month of \$339.95. This was mainly due to the bar person not ringing up sales nor keeping a sales sheet for the Tuesday Ladies event on 25 October (gain for the week of \$383.60). The stock shortages for the week (\$182.99 cost) works out to \$364.70 retail which accounts for the majority of the discrepancy.

I currently have two messages on 'bar vouchers' and 'the use of golflink card when using bar levy' displaying between sales, and 'a reminder that membership renewals are due' displaying during a sale.
